

## **Robertson County Redistricting: Year 2010**

**According to Tennessee Code Annotated 5-1-111, county governments in Tennessee are required to redistrict by January 1, 2012. This is based on 2010 census data.**

**Reapportionment/redistricting refers to the delineation of boundaries for political units, such as state legislative and county commission districts.**

**Robertson County began the process of redistricting in late July and has completed the process and was approved by the Robertson County Commission at the October 17, 2011 regular session. All documentation has been sent to the State Comptroller Office, as well as all voting precincts (old and new) for printing. New maps will not be available until late Spring with all State and City changes. The Election Office and Robertson County Planning Office have maps available with county districts, highway districts and school board districts only. A fee will apply for color or 11x17 and larger size maps.**

**The County Election Commission will publish all changed precinct/district boundaries in the Robertson County Times. These changes will not take effect until the August 2, 2012 Election.**

**Once the March 6, 2012 Election has been certified, the Election Office will be working on making changes to all affected voters. All registered voters in Robertson County will be mailed a new voter registration card with their new district/precinct, even if a change has not been made. This process must be completed before early voting begins for the August Election.**
